



In order for The University of Tennessee and you (prospective student-athlete) to maintain compliance with NCAA legislation regarding permissible benefits provided and received during an official visit, you (prospective student-athlete) must pay for any charges that appear on your hotel bill or benefits received.

The University of Tennessee may only provide the following during your official visit:

Room for the prospective student-athlete.
An additional room for parents and/or legal guardian.

The prospective student-athlete/parents/guests must pay for the following benefit(s) received:

Long distance phone calls.
Room service (unless prior approval is received by UT coaching staff).
Internet access and/or charges.
Movie/game access and/or charges.
Roll-away bed.
Extra person fee (e.g., for friend or sibling).
Fax charges

If payment is not made for any charges on your bill prior to your departure, you will be in violation of NCAA rules which may affect your eligibility. Further, if you receive a benefit, you are responsible for payment even if the charge(s) do not appear on your hotel bill. For example, if the hotel were to provide you with a complimentary movie, you would be in violation of NCAA legislation if you do not pay for it prior to your departure.
