



NCAA Bylaws limit the benefits prospective student-athletes may receive during an Official Visit to The University of Tennessee. At the end of your upcoming visit to UT's campus, you will be asked to sign a form stating that you and your parents or spouse have NOT:

- been provided alcohol, illegal drugs or sexual favors as inducements;
- attended any strip or gentleman's/lady's clubs;
- been provided with lodging or meals that are excessive in nature;
- received transportation to and from campus in excess of my actual round-trip transportation costs on a direct route between my home (or site of my athletics competition or educational institution) and campus for an official visit;
- received cash for entertainment purposes during the official visit;
- received souvenirs (e.g., t-shirts or other institutional mementos) purchased by a student host or other individuals entertaining me;
- received, at reduced or no cost, athletics gear during my official visit;
- received an automobile for use by me or my student-host during my official visit;
- had in-person contacts, either on- or off-campus, with athletics boosters, alumni, or former student-athletes who are not currently enrolled at the time of the official visit;
- been entertained outside 30 miles of the institution's campus during my official visit;
- participated in a physical work-out or other recreational activities that involve any sport for which I am being recruited while the coach was present;
- received expenses for my return trip home after remaining in the University of Tennessee's locale after the 48-hour visit expired;
- received hard tickets to a University athletic contest during my visit;
- received complimentary or reduced-cost admissions from the university for a conference/NCAA championship or post-season football contest;
- received entertainment expenses that were excessive in nature;
- had more than five (5) expense-paid visits to NCAA DI or DII member institutions.
