To Note

Starting Off

- Sophomore **Zach Rogers** made his first start at wide receiver, replacing injured senior **Gerald Jones** (hand). Rogers set career highs with three catches for a team-leading 45 yards.
- True freshman **Corey Miller** started at defensive tackle.
- Sophomore **Marsalis Teague** made his first defensive start at cornerback. He started five games at wide receiver last season. On Saturday, he set a career high with six tackles.

Weather Delay

- At 7:20 p.m. and with 8:53 remaining in the first quarter, play was suspended because of lightning, and the teams were sent to the locker rooms. The game resumed at 8:30 p.m.
- The last time the Vols had a delay of game was in 2001 against Arkansas in Fayetteville. Tennessee won 13-3.

The Offense

See Poole Run

- Junior tailback **Tauren Poole** ran up 111 yards on 8 carries in the first quarter alone, eclipsing both his career best in a game set last week against UT Martin (110 yards) and the total offensive yards New Mexico managed against Oregon in week 1 (107 yards).
- He finished with a career-high 23 carries for 162 yards.

19 Points and Counting

- Senior placekicker **Daniel Lincoln** put the Vols on the board with a 48-yard field goal, one yard shy of his career-best 49-yard kick against Ohio as a junior last season.
- He now has three 48-yard field goals in his career.
- Through two games, he has scored 19 points (4-4 field goals, 7-7 PATs). He added a 35-yard field goal in the first quarter.

Career Carry

- Freshman wide receiver **Da'Rick Rogers** registered his first career carry, taking it 21 yards on a reverse to begin the Vols' second possession.

The Defense

Tackle Leaders Post Career Highs

- The Vols' top four tackle leaders Saturday each recorded career highs.
- Senior linebacker **Nick Reveiz** led the way with 10 tackles, breaking his previous best of nine against UCLA last year. Reveiz added a tackle for a loss of four yards.
- Senior defensive end **Chris Walker** had eight tackles.
- Through two games, sophomore cornerback **Prentiss Waggner** leads the Vols with 13 tackles. He set a new career best with seven tackles.
- Senior defensive end **Gerald Williams** also had seven tackles.

First Half Hold

- After Oregon put up 59 points in the first half of its season-opening game versus New Mexico, the Vols' defense held the Ducks to just 13 in the opening two quarters, including just three allowed in the first frame.

Oregon Game Notes

No. 7 Oregon at Tennessee • Sept. 11, 2010 • Knoxville, Tenn. (Neyland Stadium)

- SO RB **LaMichael James**' 72-yard touchdown run was a career long and the first rush of 70 or more yards by a Duck since **Jeremiah Johnson** had a 76-yarder vs. Oklahoma State in the 2008 Holiday Bowl.
- James reached the century mark for the 10th time in his career, tying him for fifth all-time in 100-yard rushing games. He became the third different Duck to surpass 100 yards in a game this season.
- After his 75-yard interception return for a touchdown, all three of SO CB **Cliff Harris**' official touches this season have gone for scores (2 punt returns, 1 pick six). The INT was the second of his career.
- SO RB **Kenjon Barner** had his second career return for a touchdown - first on a punt return - with his 80-yard score in the 4th quarter.
- The 4th-quarter touchdown catch (29 yards) by SR WR **Lavasier Tuinei** was the first of his career.
- JR TE **David Paulson**, who had four catches including a TD for the second straight game, has 18 career receptions - all but two resulting in either a first down or a touchdown.
- The 2nd-quarter touchdown pass by SO QB **Darron Thomas** (to Paulson) was the first of his career in five games away from Autzen Stadium.
- Paulson set career highs in receptions (4) and receiving yards (61).
- SO K **Rob Beard** connected on the first field goal of his career, a 37-yarder in the 1st quarter.
- The crowd of 102,035 was the third-largest for a football game involving Oregon behind 2007 at Michigan (109,733) and 1995 vs. Penn State at the Rose Bowl (102,247).
- JR **Darrion Weems** made his second career start, opening at left tackle (**Bo Thran** moved to left guard and Carson York moved to right guard in place of **C.E. Kaiser**).
- The first points Oregon allowed this season came on a 48-yard FG on the game's opening drive.
- The Ducks went 5-plus quarters to start the season before allowing a touchdown.
- There was a weather delay of one hour and 10 minutes in the first quarter with UT leading 6-0.
- UO has won its last three games against teams from the SEC and is 5-0 in its last five games east of the Rocky Mountains.
- Through two games, Oregon has outscored the opposition 120-13.
